The Town of Holyrood, Newfoundland and Labrador sign Holyrood's First International Innovation and Start Up Collaboration agreement with the Letterkenny Institute of Technology, CoLab in Letterkenny, Ireland.

CoLab has played a pivotal role in changing the Ireland attitude towards innovation, risk-taking, and entrepreneurship in the Northwest. They have helped over 100 entrepreneurs to successfully start their own businesses, and they are currently home to another 28 companies.

The signing of this agreement took place on Thursday, June 22, 2017

at the Laurentic Conference in Buncaranna, Ireland where CAO Gary Corbett signed on behalf of Town of Holyrood, while the Ireland signees included John Andy Bonar Head of Development at LYIT, Mayor Gerry McMonagle County Donegal; Dr. Paul McCuster Entrepreneurial LYIT; and Don McNeil Chair of Laurentic Conference.
