#### 1. SAFETY MESSAGE

Drowning is one of the leading causes of death for Canadian children aged one to four. For every toddler who dies from drowning, it is estimated there are three to five near drowning, which require hospitalization. A small child can drown in only a few inches of water- enough to cover the mouth and nose. The most common location for infant drowning is the bathtub, but there are also high percentages of drowning in home pools and from boating accidents.

When supervising children around water, consider the following:

- Regardless of location, ensure children are supervises; whether at home or on vacation
- Ensure your backyard pool is fully fenced with a self-closing, self-latching gate, an easily retrievable first aid kit and a phone.
- When boating, ensure everyone in the boat has a properly fitted lifejacket on and fastened.
- Don't drink alcohol before or during swimming or boating activities.
- Avoid swimming in areas where there are potential currents that may be dangerous.
- Take swimming and water safety lessons and know how to respond in an emergency by taking first aid/CPR lessons.
- Learn how to properly choose and fit a life jacket for a child.
- Consider using a personal floatation device at all time around water, especially for young children and new swimmers.

Referrals were advertised in the May 5, 2016 edition of The Shoreline. 1 piece of correspondence was received.

Municipal Plan Policy 3.2.9.5 states in part: "Mineral workings shall be limited to mineral exploration within the designated protected Watershed areas." Mineral Working is the land use and the Plan restricts that use to being a mineral exploration activity.

The Watershed Land Use Zone Table, Schedule C (Development Regulations) list mineral workings as a discretionary use and in accordance with General Development Regulation 32 "Notice of Application", all Discretionary Uses must be advertised.

Council's policy on Public Briefing meetings refers to formal Development Applications to the Town. As Council views this proposal as a referral from Mineral Lands, and not a formal Development Application, it falls outside Council's policy on Public Briefing meetings.
