a. Water turn-on/off- Curb Stop Policy

BE IT RESOLVED that the town of Holyrood approve the Water turn on/off, Curb stop policy, HP-002. This policy will ensure water turn on/off, curb stop governance and regulations are followed in the long-term planning for the Town of Holyrood.

b. Water Supply Upgrade

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Holyrood request Innovative Engineering to prepare a fair and reasonable bid for engineering services to complete the project identified as Water Supply Upgrades (17-GI-21-00049). Our request for a fair and reasonable bid will allow the Town to secure the services of Innovative Engineering to prepare a Prime Consultant Agreement and oversee the execution of the scope of work associated with this project.

This project will allow the Town to supply and install a 500,000-gallon water tank, installation of control systems and integration with the existing distribution system. It will provide the necessary water mains valves and boxes to connect to the existing system. This will allow the Town to provide reliable, continuous water access to residents.

c. Sewer and Pumps Upgrade

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Holyrood request Innovative Engineering to prepare a fair and reasonable bid for engineering services to complete the project identified as AP-MYCW-17-119 Sewer & Pumps Upgrade. Our request for a fair and reasonable bid will allow the Town to secure the services of Innovative Engineering to prepare a Prime Consultant Agreement and oversee the execution of the scope of work associated with this project.

This project will evaluate the present condition of the pumps at the Town's lift stations and replace those which need to be replaced. This project is the first step in a much more comprehensive sewer upgrade plan initiated by the Town.
