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- The permit holder shall have at the location of the fire at least one person and adequate firefighting equipment and water supply for use to extinguish the fire if it becomes necessary.
- The fire shall not exceed **1.5** square meter(s)
- No more than **1** fire shall be burning at one time.
- The fire shall be, at all times, no less than a distance of **15** meters from any uncleared lands, woodlands, adjacent buildings or structures, grasslands or forest land.
- The permit holder shall not leave any fire unattended until it is extinguished.
- The permit holder shall not permit a fire to burn during periods of high, very high or extreme fire weather index or in winds over **20** kilometers per hour.
- Under no circumstances does this permit relieve the permit holder of liability for injury, loss damages, costs or otherwise which may be caused by fire(s) lit under this permit.
- This permit may be cancelled or suspended at anytime by the Fire Chief of the Town of Holyrood Fire Department or by a member of the Holyrood Fire Department authorized by the Fire Chief.
- A person who fails to comply with the provisions and conditions of this permit is guilty of an offense under the Town of Holyrood Open Air Fire Regulations.
- A copy of the permit for an open- air-fire is to be on site where the fire is taking place and must be shown when requested by a member of the Holyrood Fire Department.
- This permit is not transferable or otherwise assigned by the permit holder.
- When burning in a barrel the distance from combustible dwelling shall be a minimum of 15 meters.
- The barrel shall be equipped with the spark arrestor that has a mesh no larger than 0.5 inches.
- The permit becomes void if a ban on open fires is declared by an authorizing agency.
- The fire must be attended at all times and shall be extinguished prior to darkness.
- This permit does not allow for the burning of heavy oils, items containing natural or synthetic rubber, animal carcasses or animal wastes, asphaltic products, waste petroleum paints, plastics, aerosol cans, electric wiring, treated wood products or any other material other than plant growth, paper products or untreated wood construction wastes.
