The NLSCA administers the COR program to help ensure OHS standardization for the province's construction companies. Until recently there have been three categories within the NLCSA's COR program. A company could have received a Letter of Good Standing stating *In Process*, *Audit Pending*, or *Certificate of Recognition*.

Tenders for contracts that would typically have a COR requirement must use the following language:

The Contractor shall within 14 days of award of the contract, and prior to commencement of the work, provide a Letter of Good Standing stating Certificate of Recognition (COR) certified from the Newfoundland and Labrador Construction Safety Association (NLCSA)."

3. Description of the Works

The scope of work under this RFQ includes Paving in the Town of Holyrood. The attached spreadsheet outlines the areas to be priced.

Price all areas separately on spreadsheet provided.

#1 Sir Albert Walsh Drive, by Marina, 19'-6" x 225' (5.9m x 68.5m), Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt.

#2 The Valley, From the top of The Valley Road, across from the daycare to the 4 way stop, 13'-6" x 1100' (4.1m x 335m), Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt to tie into new asphalt installed at the 4 way stop in 2021.

#3 Timmon's Lane, off 4 way stop in The Valley, 10ft x 215ft (3m x 65.5m) remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt to tie into new asphalt installed at the 4 way stop in 2021

#4 The Valley, across from civic #34, PATCH, 5ft x 75ft (1.5m x 23m), Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt.

#5 Bog Lane, from the intersection with Route 60, 13'-6" x 130' (4.1m x 40m), Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt.

#6 Country Path, from civic #19 to #25, 20ft x 415ft (6m x 126.5 m) Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt to tie into new asphalt installed in 2021.

#7 Country Path, from civic #104 heading North toward Route 60, 19ft x 440ft (5.8m x 134.1m), Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt.

#8 Country Path, North from civic #74, 19ft x 223ft (5.8m x 68m) to new asphalt installed in 2020, Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt.

#9 Country Path, North from new asphalt at civic #70, 19ft x 600ft (5.8m x 183m), Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt.

#10 Northside Road, two PATCHES by Maloney's Pond, 8ft x 20ft (2.4m x 6m) and 8ft x 25ft (2.4m x 7.6m), Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt.

#11 Intersection of Godson's Road and Route 60, 43ft (13m) wide at Route 60, 30ft (9m) in depth where the width is 20ft (6m), Asphalt is removed, install class a and new asphalt.

#12 Intersection of Byrne's Road and Route 60, 70ft (21m) wide at Route 60, 100ft (30.5m) in depth where the width is 16'-6" (5m), Remove existing asphalt, install class A, install new asphalt.

Any change in the contract will be dealt with through "change orders" generated by the contractor and approved by the Town of Holyrood.

The Town reserves the right to change the unite quantities in any area as the project may determine. The Town may spend less than the total contract dollar amount to meet Town of Holyrood budget allotments.

Bidders can request a site meeting as detailed in the RFQ advertisement.

Contractor will leave all areas in a clean, tidy condition once the paving has been complete.

Contractor responsible for damages to Town owned Infrastructure.

Shouldering is required in all areas.

Paving to be 2" (50mm) as per Provincial Government specifications.

All areas to be identified by the Town of Holyrood.


